Global TA: HIV Technical Support Program in Ukraine

In partnership with the Ukrainian Ministry of Health, ICAP is providing technical assistance and implementation support to increase antiretroviral (ART) coverage nationally and improve the quality and efficiency of HIV service delivery. ICAP is working with the Ukrainian Public Health Center to develop and implement new protocols, approaches, and tools that support decentralized, comprehensive HIV care and treatment services. ICAP is also building the capacity of national and regional multidisciplinary teams in 12 PEPFAR-supported oblasts in clinical mentorship and quality improvement methodologies. Activities focus on implementing Test and Start and ART optimization, as well as improving retention in care and treatment and viral suppression for all people living with HIV, including people who inject drugs and their sex partners, as these populations are most affected by the HIV epidemic in Ukraine.
