



Introduction to the Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Training Package

The Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Training Package was developed by ICAP at Columbia University to support PrEP implementation. The curriculum and tools serve as a foundation for PrEP service delivery and can be adapted to align with specific policy, health system, and epidemic contexts. As PrEP evolves, these documents will require updating to reflect scientific and implementation advances. The package includes:

1. PrEP Training for Providers in Clinical Settings Curriculum

- PrEP Training Slide Set
 - Slides **#10, 27, 37, 40, 56, and 238** are designed for adaption to local context.
- PrEP Trainer Manual
- PrEP Participant Manual, includes job aids
- A Certification of Completion template

2. PrEP Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Tools

- PrEP Screening for Substantial Risk and Eligibility
 - Standardizes the process for determining PrEP eligibility.
- PrEP Screening Log
 - Summarizes information from the PrEP Screening for Substantial Risk and Eligibility form, including PrEP eligibility, acceptance, and initiation for each client screened.
- PrEP Facility Record
 - A PrEP client medical record, which also capture each PrEP follow-up visit.
- PrEP Client Register
 - Summarizes key longitudinal information for each PrEP client.
- Seroconversion Tracker
 - Tracks outcomes for clients who acquire HIV while prescribed PrEP.
- PrEP Monthly Summary Form
 - A template for routine monthly aggregate reporting on PrEP services.
- PrEP Quarterly Cohort Report
 - A template for calculating and reporting quarterly PrEP client outcomes, such as retention and follow-up HIV testing.

3. PrEP Training of Trainers (TOT): This prepares individuals to deliver the PrEP Training for Providers in Clinical Settings curriculum to participants. TOT materials include:
